



- Issue: Some 2007-2011 model year RX 350 and 2010-2011 model year RX 450h vehicles may exhibit a leak or oil seep from the engine oil cooler pipes. Follow the repair procedure in this bulletin to address this condition.

Repair Information

- 1. Confirm the leak or seep is from either of the oil cooler pipes. If neither oil cooler pipe is leaking or seeping, this bulletin does NOT apply.
- 2. Remove and replace the oil cooler pipe assembly.
- 3. Confirm the engine oil level is correct.
- 4. Start the engine and confirm there's no leaking or seeping from the oil cooler pipes.
