

Honda Inline Filters

Before flushing the cooler lines on a Honda look for an inline filter. Some Hondas will have an OE filter and some Honda cars and trucks may have an additional filter installed by the dealership under warranty. The filter may be hidden under the radiator or above the transmission. If you find an inline filter in the cooler line please remove it before flushing the cooler.



As you can see from the pictures this filter can be full of metal. The filter does have a bypass spring but if the filter is clogged it will cut down the cooler flow and it could cause overheating.

These filters are available from Honda and were OE on some cars as you can see from this picture:



If you do elect to replace the filter always let the customer know that there is an inline filter installed on his or her vehicle and it needs to be replaced on a regular basis.
